



Did you know you can earn **CME and MOC** for all of Your DynaMedex Usage?

Just a few simple steps are all it takes

- 1 Create a personal user account by logging into DynaMedex from your institution, clicking "SIGN IN" in the upper right-hand corner, followed by "Register Now" and complete the form.
- 2 Once you are signed in a CME ticker will appear next to your name. Click the CME ticker, and you will land on the CME tracking page. Click the "Settings" icon to the right and adjust your settings to receive the appropriate CME and MOC credits.
- 3 Now that you have configured your CME and MOC settings you will start earning credits for all of your DynaMedex activity!

To submit your CME credits, simply click the CME ticker in the upper right-hand corner of the DynaMedex navigation and follow the instructions on the CME/CPD/CE and MOC page. Credits can be submitted individually or in bulk, and MOC credits will be submitted automatically on your behalf after the easy one-time configuration.
