**MedicLatina** is a unique collection of medical research and scientific journals from renowned Latin American and Spanish publishers. It contains a complete table of contents and PDF full text for peer-reviewed medical journals in the Spanish language.

**Enfermería al Día** is a comprehensive nursing tool providing clinical Spanish-language resources to nurses and other healthcare professionals. Resources include point-of-care reference material, nursing skills and procedures, patient education and more.
