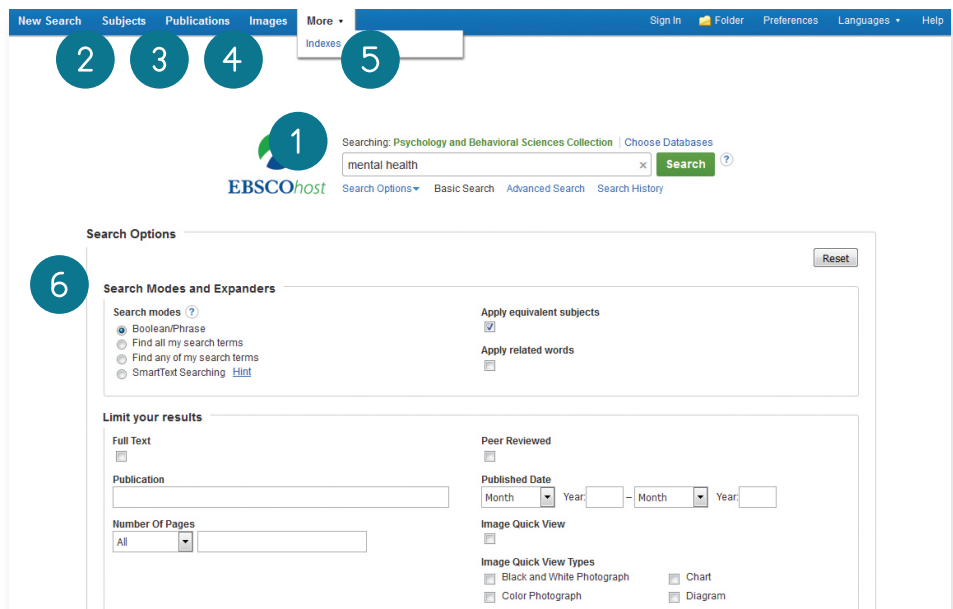

# Features of Psychology & Behavioral Sciences Collection

## Search Screen

- 1 **Search Box:** Start by entering keywords to search journals, book reviews, magazines and more.
- 2 **Subject Browse:** Browse articles using EBSCO's controlled vocabulary of terms that assists in the effective searching of academic content.
- 3 **Publications Browse:** Find articles by browsing available publications.
- 4 **Image Browse:** Look through thousands of image thumbnails.
- 5 **More Browsing Options:** Browse by specific citation credentials or within an indexed field, including by Author, Document Type, Language, etc.
- 6 **Search Modes:** Search using Boolean Operators or exact phrases, automatically place AND or OR between your search terms, or search using large amounts of text with SmartText Searching.



## Result List Screen

- 1 **Current Search:** Quickly view your current search selections and update your search results by removing selected items.
- 2 **Limit Your Results:** Refine your searches without navigating away from the results page.
- 3 **Facets:** Filter by source type, related subjects and more.
- 4 **Search History:** Display or hide search history and create alerts.
- 5 **Personal Folder:** Create a personal My EBSCOhost folder to save articles, links to searches, images and more.
- 6 **Image Quick View:** Preview thumbnail images from full-text articles and EBSCO's Image Collection.
